

## Creative Preschool COVID Policy Highlights

Updated 8/2022

-Drop-off services will again be offered, parents WILL BE allowed to enter the building to drop-off, volunteer and pick up their child. Regardless of vaccination status, all adults entering the building will not be required to wear a mask.

-All adult helpers, regardless of vaccination status, do not need to wear a mask.

-Symptom assessment will NO LONGER include temporal scans.

-Mandatory handwashing will take place upon arrival, before snack and at dismissal. Children and staff will wash hands after blowing their noses or touching bodily fluids.

-Creative Preschool students will NOT be required to wear masks but may do so if they wish.

-Field trips will be booked as deemed safe and appropriate by staff.

-All positive COVID cases are reported to our licensing body and quarantine guidance will be given on a case-by-case basis by the local health department.

## Pandemic Emergency Response

Creative Preschool will implement the Pandemic Section of the Crisis Management Plan under the guidance and direction of the CDC, federal and local governments, and the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services Child Care Regulation.

To ensure the safety of children, families and staff the center will monitor the situation and take into account the guidance and suggestions from the authorities on the situation. Decisions made by the center will consider the safety of children, families and staff. Decisions may include:

- Closure of the center
  - Length of closure to be determined by center, CDC, federal and local governments, the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services Child Care Regulation.
- Adjusted hours of service
- Daily health checks of children and staff
- Expectation of required handwashing
- Expectation of required wearing of face covering
- Limited entry into the building by adults
- Limited access to the property

The center will communicate these plans through a variety of methods such as mass email, written communication when possible, and Facebook.
